**An excursion and guided visit of D-day landing beaches and Norman cider house** are scheduled on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2017 afternoon (2.00pm – 7h30 pm). You will first go to La Ferme de la Sapinière :

This farm is typical of the Bessin area of Calvados, with its architecture, dairy cows and cider apple orchards. You will discover the ins and outs of cider making and learn all about the history of apples. You will see how tradition and craftmanship come together in the savoir-faire of the farm's landlords. The visit winds up with the pleasurable tasting of apple juices, ciders, Pommeau de Normandie and Calvados.

After this, you will drive towards Omaha Beach, where the Americans lost so many, and the American cemetery in Colleville: a site of over 170 acres housing 9387 tombs and a wall of the missing.

From there we will reach Arromanches:

Clifftop at Arromanches you will admire the remains of the British Royal Engineers brillantly conceived Mulberry Port.
